Ms. Tong was also an Ash Center Research fellow at the Harvard Kennedy School. Ms. Tong also worked for the California State Senate Minority Leader's Office as the Chief Asian American Affairs Advisor. For her many years of service, she was awarded a Coro Public Affairs Fellowship and the Chairperson of the Los Angeles County Community Action Board.
