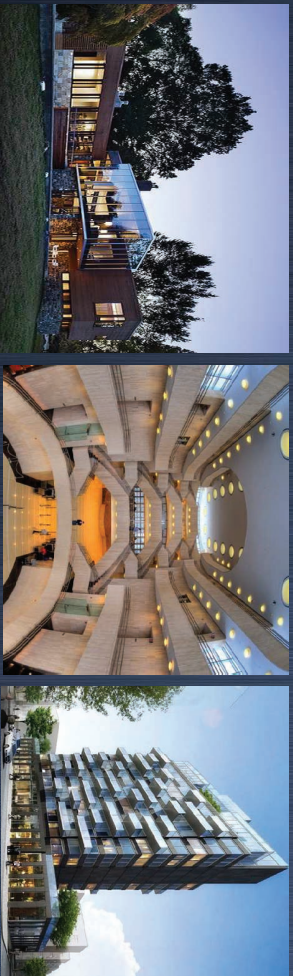

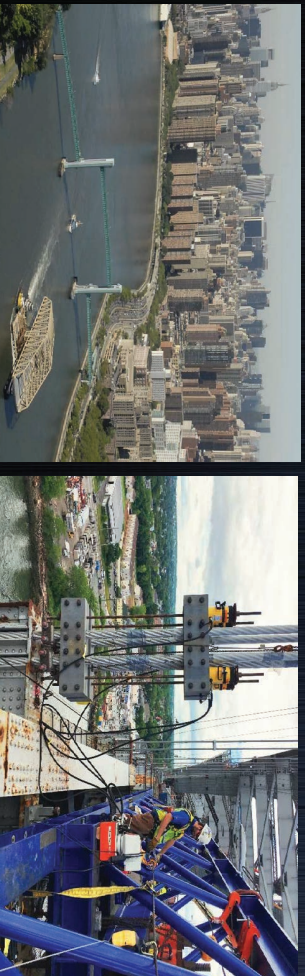

Belleville Historical Society

Founded in 1962, the Belleville Historical Society celebrates and shares Belleville's long and rich 300 year history. Our history includes the building of the first steam engine in America in 1753, serving as the base of the patriot militia during the American Revolution, home to anti-slavery leaders prior to the Civil War and home to the first successful Chinese community in this part of the US.

Belleville, formerly known as the village of Second River, was established on the 4th of July in 1797 by veterans of the American Revolution. Among our many year round activities, our Society assists in maintaining the cemetery of the old Belleville Reformed Church, the final resting place of sixty-eight Revolutionary War soldiers. Each year the Society hosts its biggest event the 4th of July morning ceremony at the cemetery complete with a 21 gun cannon salute.

During the month of February the Society sponsors a fascinating and colorful Chinese-American History exhibit at the Belleville Public Library. Each April the Society and the United Chinese-American Association of New Jersey remember Belleville's 19th century Chinese community and the first Chinese immigrants buried here by hosting our Ching Ming observance at the Chinese Memorial located in the cemetery of the old Belleville Reformed Church.

The Society was also responsible for the creating and celebrating Belleville's Black History Month exhibit. Belleville also played a unique role in the anti-slavery movement and was the home of several of America's leading abolitionists.

The Society is part of the Wreaths Across America organization which honors America's deceased veterans each Christmas season by placing wreaths on the graves of hundreds of local veterans.



Michael Perrone
PRESIDENT OF BELLEVILLE HISTORICAL SOCIETY

Michael was born in Newark, NJ four months after his parents and their three other children arrived by ship from Italy on New Year's Day 1956. Italian was the language spoken in the home and still is today to a large extent. The Perrone family has been

in the construction business since 1960. Michael grew up in a tight knit family with two brothers and two sisters. Michael's greatest lesson in life came from helping to take care of his older sister Maria who was confined to a wheelchair for fifty-five years, from age 15 to 71. Helping those in need and understanding what is truly important in life was instilled into his spirit at a young age. He has been entertaining the children at and raising money for the 1st Cerebral Palsy Center of NJ for many years.

Michael attended Belleville High School where he was the founder and president of the Belleville High School Political Club and he attended Rutgers University in Newark. From 1986 until 2001 Michael served as an assistant to New Jersey State Assemblyman John V. Kelly, working on a wide variety of issues.

Michael was first introduced to Chinese culture in 1980 when he became familiar with the Tao, Tai Chi, I Ching, and Feng Shui. As a lover of history he was familiar with the Opium wars and the Boxer Rebellion. Michael has been a member of the Belleville Historical Society for over twenty years and has been president for the past five.

In 2015 the Belleville Historical Society discovered that Belleville was home to the first Chinese community on the east coast of the U.S. Michael led the effort to construct the monument to these first Chinese immigrants, several of whom are buried at the old Belleville Reformed Church. Each year he creates a Chinese history exhibit at the Belleville Public Library for Chinese New Year and every April hosts the Ching Ming observance at the Chinese monument at the old Belleville Reformed Church cemetery. His work has been widely covered by the U.S. and Chinese media. Michael is currently involved in producing a short book and video on New Jersey's Chinese-American history.

Kenneth Hsu



Kenneth was born in Taiwan and moved to the United States when he was 10 years old. With almost two decades of experience in software development, he is currently the Principal Software Architect at Winnill Software in New York City. Kenneth is also the creator of the Twitter account @nj_vaccine which provided immediate alerts on hard-to-find COVID-19 vaccine appointments across New Jersey. Launched in February 2021, the account gained over 89,000 followers and helped countless NJ residents get vaccinated. His efforts were recognized by the State of New Jersey's Office of Innovation and he was invited to partner with the government to create a state sponsored Vaccine Finder Tool. He is a husband and a father of three young children. Outside of work, he enjoys sports, movies, and coaching his son's little league baseball team.



Center for Asian Health at St. Barnabas Medical Center

The Chinese Health Initiative within The Center for Asian Health was developed to meet the health care needs of the Chinese-American population in Northern New Jersey. We offer culturally relevant medical care and provide individualized support for patients to obtain the medical services they need.

Peter Lee, MD



Dr. Peter Lee was born in Beijing China and came to the USA at the age of 4. Along with his parents and little sister they lived in Albany NY while his father was obtaining his PhD. His family then moved to North Jersey. His first passion was soccer and he played semi professionally for 2 years—then he decided to go into medicine to be an Emergency Medicine physician with the hopes of medical mission trips in the upcoming future. Dr. Lee

currently lives in Montville, NJ with his wife Grace and their three children: Chloe (6), Arielle (4), Owen (1).



Su Wang, MD

Su Wang, MD, MPH is an internal medicine physician and the Medical Director of Viral Hepatitis Programs & the Center for Asian Health at Saint Barnabas Medical Center in New Jersey, USA. She is living with hepatitis B and is the current President of the World Hepatitis Alliance (WHA), a non governmental organization whose mission is to harness the power of people living with viral hepatitis to achieve its elimination. Her work with WHA has focused on amplifying the voice of people living with hepatitis and the affected communities in order to achieve health equity on the road to hepatitis elimination.

She received her medical degree from the University of Miami and her Masters of Public Health from Johns Hopkins School of Public Health. Dr. Wang completed a combined Internal Medicine and Pediatric residency at Georgetown University Hospital and then served as an Epidemic Intelligence Service officer for the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) at the US Food and Drug Administration (FDA). She was previously the Director of Hepatitis Programs at the Charles B. Wang Community Health Center in New York City. Dr. Wang lives with her husband and 4 children in New Providence.



Honorable Theresa L. Yang

Judge Theresa L. Yang was born in New York City. She obtained her B.A. from Rutgers College. During college, she co-founded the Asian Children's Charity Association, ACCA, which provided impoverished children in Asian countries with food, shelter, clothing and medicine. She served in ACCA's Executive Board. She also was the Editor-in-Chief of *Asia Rutgers*, a college publication which featured articles of concern to the Asian community. Judge Yang received her JD. from Pace University School of Law. She was the recipient of a Public Interest Law School Organization Grant which allowed her to intern with the Westchester Legal Services.

She was recognized in a 2003 issue of the *NJ Law Journal* highlighting Top Minority Attorneys and Women in the Legal Profession. She served on the Executive Board of the Asian Pacific American Lawyers' Association of NJ, APALANJ. Judge Yang was appointed to the NJ Supreme Court Committee regarding Women in the Courts and to the NJ Advisory Committee on Police Standards. She then served as the President of APALANJ from 2005-2006. She gave seminars regarding NJ Workers' Compensation topics and was a panelist in a Rutgers Law School Women of Color seminar. She served as a Moot Court Competition Judge at Rutgers Law School-Newark. Prior to her judicial appointment, she was an in-house Workers' Compensation defense lawyer for Greater New York Insurance Company. Judge Yang was appointed to the NJ Workers' Compensation bench on July 2, 2009. She currently works solely in the Newark Workers' Compensation Court.



Dana Dang

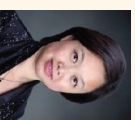
Dana Dang came to the U.S. 30 years ago and graduated from Suffolk University in Boston. She has been a full-time realtor for 26 years. Shau Zhang

Shau is Partner and leader of Americas China Overseas Investment (COIN) at Ernst & Young LLP (EY). She is responsible for serving the dynamic needs of cross-border investors

and businesses from China operating through EY's Americas Region (North, Central, Latin, Israel). In her leadership capacity, Shau has facilitated cross-border trade activity in the tens of billions, including some of the largest inbound transactions in history. On these transactions, she has advised clients at the C-suite and Chairman level on the cooperative and business practices that will facilitate sustainable value creation. Under Shau's leadership, EY has become a recognized market leader among Chinese inbound investors. She has consistently grown her business unit revenue at a 20% CAGR rate. Across EY's global network, Shau is known as an extraordinary leader and a great inspiration for Chinese professionals in the industry. Although she did not originally come from an accounting nor English-speaking background (Shau's undergrad experience was in mechanical engineering, and her second language was Russian), Shau was one of the first few exceptional Chinese talents who made partner in the EY US firm. Shau remains the only Chinese woman serving as a Global Client Service Partner at EY US.

Shau is an activist in helping to facilitate dialogue between businesses in the US and China. Shau is a member of the Business Advisory Council of the Asia Society in New York, and has been recognized as one of the Top Outstanding 50 Asian Americans in Business in 2016 by the Asian American Business Development Center. Shau was one of the first sponsors of the China General Chamber of Commerce-USA, a proud supporter of the National Committee of US-China Relations, and a trusted friend of the Children of China Pediatric Foundation. Shau is actively involved in her college alumni association, Chiao-Tung University Alumni Association in America (CTUAA), she is a member of the CTUAA board. Shau has held a panel at 2015 Reunion at Los Angeles, and webinars of US-China relations and been organizing more activities in the near future.

Shau has an MS in Accountancy and an MS in Taxation from Bentley University, Massachusetts, and BS and MS degrees in Power Mechanical Engineering from Shanghai Jiaotong University. She is a Certified Public Accountant in Massachusetts, and a member of the MSCPA and AICPA.



Josephine Ho

Josephine Ho was born in 1953 in Hong Kong. She immigrated with her parents and two brothers to the United States at the age of 9 and grew up in New York City's Chinatown. At the young age of 15, Josephine began volunteering at the CPC (Chinese American Planning Council). This experience instilled in her a lifelong dedication to the community's needs and the importance of advocacy.

She graduated from Cornell University as the first generation immigrant in her family to attend an Ivy League college. During her college years, Josephine and fellow students formed the Asian-American Coalition to advocate for Asian-American Studies and the establishment of an Ethnic Studies Center. She was also tasked with recruiting more Chinese-American students from Chinatown to attend Cornell and be a "big sister" for those who came. After college, Josephine's work consistently revolved around community service and education. She enjoyed teaching English as a second language at the San Francisco Chinatown Community College, served as VP and President of Cincinnati's Chinese-American Association, and helped establish the first Chinese Language Program at Cincinnati's Walnut Hills High School. After obtaining a Master's degree in Community Health Planning and Administration at University of Cincinnati, she worked for the Cincinnati Health Department and helped obtain a \$17 million Johnson Foundation grant. Throughout her life, Josephine was committed to serving the community with dedication, kindness, and compassion through collaboration and partnership building.

Upon completion of her husband's medical training, the Ho family settled in the southern New Jersey shore where they raised two children. In her early years of motherhood, she was a homemaker. Guided by school teacher and godmother, Mrs. Virginia Kee,

she also spent 30 years serving as a board member of the Chinese-American Planning Council (CPC), devoting much of her time helping the immigrants from Asia in their new community she so much loved. In 2010, Josephine Ho joined the New Jersey Chinese-American Chamber of Commerce (NJCAAC) as the Executive Director. Through her dedication to these two organizations, she helped nurture an environment that has deep and lasting effects on the Asian American communities in New Jersey and metro New York.

With the support of the dedicated Board of Directors and members of the NJCAAC, Josephine promoted business among members and organized special informative seminars, panel discussions and networking functions that served the Asian-American business community through advocacy and sharing of knowledge and success stories. For her work through NJCAAC, Josephine received an award in 2019 from National Asian/Pacific Islander American Chamber of Commerce & Entrepreneurship in honor and appreciation for her leadership and dedication to the Asian-American Business Community. In December 2018, she also received an award from the New Jersey Chapter of Overseas Chinese Association (OCA-NU) in recognition of her dedicated service to the New Jersey Asian-American Community.

In November 2019, Josephine suffered a stroke and passed away at the age of 66. She was survived by her husband, Dr. Peter Ho, a radiation oncologist, son Dr. Derek Ho, physicist in New York City, and daughter Kendra Ho, IT project manager in San Diego.

John Lau, with his wife Betty, founded Appliedinfo Partners 30 years ago. One of their software products, Divtrak, became the pioneering cornerstone technology for Fortune 1000 corporations to track their diversity suppliers programs. Today, Appliedinfo Partners business divisions include D2 Cybersecurity, a technology risk management company that provides cybersecurity training, security gap assessment and penetration testing for critical IT infrastructures. D2 Cybersecurity currently serves more than 150 NJ school districts and

Charles Pei Wang



Charles Pei Wang is currently President of the Chinese-American Cultural & Art Association. In 1994, Mr. Wang served under Governor Mario Cuomo as an Assistant Commissioner for Downstate Operations with the NY State Department of Social Services. In 1995 he became the Executive Director to head up the Greater Blouse, Skirt & Undergarment Association, a 500 members garment trade association in New York City.

From 1968 to 1989, Mr. Wang worked at the Chinese American Planning Council (CPC) as Managing Director and later as the Executive Director, and helped make CPC one of the largest and most prominent social services agencies for the Chinese-American community. From 1989 to 1993, Mr. Wang served as President of China Institute in America

and brought back to life this age-old culture and art institution founded in 1930. Mr. Wang made possible the first public hearing on New York Asian-American Affairs sponsored by the U.S. Commission on Civil Rights in 1974, the publication of Outlook of Asian-Americans in New York, by United Way-Tri State in 1989. From 1990 to 1995, Mr. Wang was appointed by then President George H.W. Bush as Vice Chairman of U.S. Commission on Civil Rights, the History of Discrimination Against Asian-Americans in U.S., was published by the Commission. Among many visible accomplishments, the opening of a Social Security Administration office, in Chinatown; the construction of new public housing, hospital, senior housing, public school, new post office, the formation of the Chinese Immigrant Service Organizations of North America, the Committee of 100, and the Asian-American Federation of New York City.

He was appointed by President Jimmy Carter as a member of the President's Commission on Mental Health/Asian American Panel. In 1982, he was elected as Secretary on the Board of Directors of the United Way of New York City. In 1989, on the Board of New York City Partnership, Emblem Health Service. He was Co-Chairman of the Human Service Council of New York, Vice Chairman of the New York City Health System Agency, and Chairman of the U.S. Bureau of the Census 1990-2000 Asian and Pacific Islanders Advisory Committee, under President Ford and Reagan; Co-Chairman of China AIDS Fund, National Advisory Board to U.S. Department of Labor, under President George W. Bush, just to name a few. Mr. Wang received numerous awards, such as Ellis Island Medal of Honor, Charles Wang Day in Manhattan, Distinguished Service Award given by governmental, educational and services organizations, too numerous to mention.

Construction Dewatering is the removal of groundwater from soils via pumping. Usually dewatering occurs prior to excavation for the purpose of lowering the water table and/or removing perched water. Dewatering systems are installed within post excavation and erected difficult or even unsafe working conditions.

TSGS provides Permitting, Dewatering, and filtration services including systems design, installation operation and maintenance. Dewatering methods include Deep Wells, Wellpoints, Ejectors and Sumps.

Groundwater Treatment

Groundwater Treatment is the process of removing contaminants from groundwater to discharge clean water. Some projects are known to be contaminated like Superfund or Brownfield sites. Other projects are found to be contaminated.

TSGS will design a site-specific temporary or permanent treatment system based on contamination and flow rates to meet state and/or local discharge standards.

Geotechnical Services

While Geotechnical Services are very broad TSGS focuses on Subsurface drilling like Micropile Installation, Helow Bar Micropile, Large Diameter caissons (up to 8'), H-piles, soldier beams for temporary earth retention, and Tie-backs to PDE.

Environmental Remediation

In-situ chemical oxidation (ISCO) has become one of the most popular site remediation solutions to reduce the toxicity of organic contaminants. TSGS has been successful in treating a wide range of organic and inorganic substances including strong chemical oxidizers directly into the contaminated medium (soil or groundwater) to destroy chemical contaminants in place.

TSGS uses direct push technology to provide operational flexibility compared to traditional techniques.

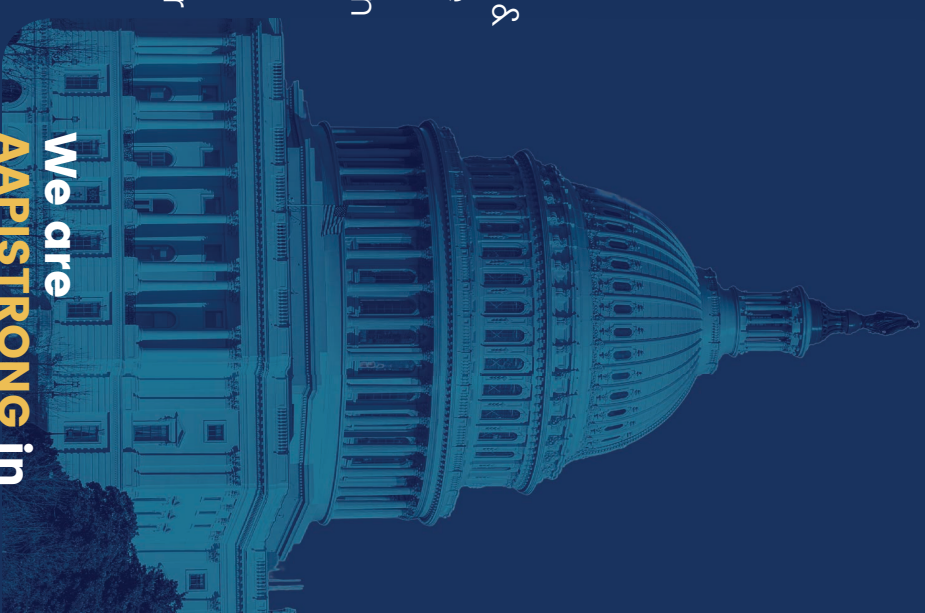
