Dr. Youpeng Wang, also known as Xiaolong Wang, is a visionary leader, banker, investor and entrepreneur, with over 40 years of knowledge across all aspects of Capital Markets, he brings a rich experience of leading various prestigious financial institutions in Asia. Considered as the pioneer and founder of China's capital markets, Mr. Wang has been instrumental in designing processes to modernize

and establish an Asset Management Market System in China, Mr Wang has been a key person in establishing guidelines for market operations and regulatory systems of multiple industries in China.

As the CEO of Beijing International Trust Co., Ltd. (BITIC) from 1998-2015, Dr. Wang raised the company assets under management to over 1 Trillion RMB (160B USD), with a 605% increase in revenues, 9708% increase in gross profit and 11450% increase in net profit. Under his stewardship, by 2015 BITIC became the best performing company in China's financial industry, and Dr. Wang was named the Best Leader in Trust in 2015.

Currently Dr. Wang is the CEO of Silverline Group. Dr. Wang currently resides in Manhattan, NY. Dr. Wang earned a B.A. degree from Shanxi University, and a PhD in Economics/Finance from Peking University.

Her workas Executive Director of the Children's Orchestra Society has been recognized by multiple awards. She studied violin with Dr. H. T. Ma, Firmin Touche, Arthur Grumiaux, and Koji Toyoda, piano with Germaine Mounier and Rose Simon, and chamber music with Leon Kirchner, gave her first recital on violin and piano at age 7,was the winner of French National Competition, Royaume de la Musique at age 10, played Mendelssohn Violin Concerto at age 11 with the Denver Symphony Orchestra, and more recently performs in chamber music groups with COS faculty and friends.

The Children's Orchestra Society (COS), founded in 1962 by Dr. H.T. Ma, is a not-for-profit organization dedicated to "teaching the language of music" to children and teens. Our mission is to cultivate and nurture children and teach them teamwork and lifeskills through music-learning and performing in orchestral and chamber music settings, using a child-centered approach. COS members receive excellent training in classical music and opportunities to perform in concerts with their peers as well as with well-established musicians, and reach out to the community to play concerts benefiting victims of natural disasters. Professional Achievement Award DR. TEIK C. LIM, President, NJIT

Dr. Teik C. Lim started as the 9th President of the New Jersey Institute of Technology on July 1, 2022. Prior to NJIT, Dr. Lim led the University of Texas at Arlington (UTA) since early 2020 as the interim president and was Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs from 2017-2020.

Dr. Lim's career has spanned from the private sector to university administration. He worked as an engineer at Structural Dynamics Research Corporation before joining The Ohio State University Center for Automotive Research as a research scientist. He taught at the University of Alabama beginning in 1998, as associate professor, before joining the University of Cincinnati in 2002, where he advanced from associate professor, professor and department head to associate dean for graduate studies and research and, ultimately, Dean of the College of Engineering and Applied Science.

Dr. Lim earned his Bachelor of Science in Mechanical Engineering (ME) from Michigan Technological University, his Master of Science in ME from the University of Missouri-Rolla, and his Ph.D. in ME from The Ohio State University.

Dr. Lim is internationally recognized as a leading scholar in the field of structural vibrations and acoustics as well as modeling and simulation technology. He was named Fellow of National Academy of Inventors in 2018. He is Fellow of ASME, the American Society of Mechanical Engineers, and of SAE, the Society of Automotive Engineers, from which he received numerous research and teaching awards such as the Arch T. Colwell Merit Award in 2003 and the Ralph R. Teetor Educational Award in 2002. He was also recognized with the Thomas French Alumni Achievement Award in 2010, GearLab Distinguished Alumnus Award in 2017, and Distinguished Alumni Award for Academic Excellence in 2019 from his alma mater, The Ohio State University.



Cultural Ambassador Award

SHENGHUA HU, Internationally Acclaimed Violinist, The Metropolitan Opera

Shenghua Simon Hu, Chinese violinist, conductor, is the first Chinese person to serve as the Principal Second Violin of Metropolitan Opera Orchestra, the United States. He once won the Grammy Awards and the gold awards of the International Violin Competition for many times. He is currently the director and conductor of The New York Chamber Orchestra, and active in the stages all over the world. Hu is one of the youngest Principal Violinist of the famous orchestras all over the

world. At the age of 29, he served as the Principal Second Violin of Metropolitan Opera Orchestra. Nowadays, Shenghua Simon Hu is the most influential Chinese violinist, who is the only Chinese apprentice of Albert Markov - known as King of Paganini. Just like Bruce lee - one of apprentices of Yip Man in Chinese Martial art, Shenghua Simon Hu is the classic legend of Chinese music circle, and the pride of oriental classical music circle.

In 2006, he was admitted into College -Conservatory of Music, University of Cincinnati with full scholar-ship, tutored by Kurt Sassmannshaus - the international master violinist, and Shenghua granted the highest scholarship of "Starling Foundation". From 2008 to 2015, he pursued advanced studies under the guidance of violin mogul Albert Markov - the gold medal winner of the Elizabeth Violin Competition. Over the years, he has established cooperation with many artists, including James Levine, Simon Rattle, GustavoDudamel, YannickNézet-Séguin, Valery Gergiev, Fabio Luisi and many famous conductors.

Mr. Hou achieved remarkable accomplishments in his position.

Early in Sally's career, she also served as Corporate Vice President and the national Chinese Market Manager at New York Life, playing an instrumental role in establishing the Company's dominant presence in the domestic Chinese Market.

Sally has an extensive background in strategic planning, business development, and risk management. She holds two gold standard designations in financial planning, including the Certified Financial Planner (CFP®) & Chartered Financial Consultant (ChFC®) titles. She is also a real estate broker licensee in New York State as well as a life and health insurance licensee in numerous states. Her unique expertise in asset allocation, real estate investment, life and health insurance, and financial and tax planning allows the group of firms she leads to provide professional advice of a "family office" caliber to high net-worth individuals/families, in addition to offering general real estate and insurance services to the public. Community Service Award UA3

Since the start of the Covid-19 pandemic in March 2020, UA3 has stepped up its vital role as an on-the-ground community partner ensuring uninterrupted, direct support for the neediest local residents. We have distributed over \$20M worth of fresh produce and food products, ten million facial masks, and \$10M worth of hand sanitizers and related healthcare products. Our recipients include fragile seniors, undocumented residents,

people with disabilities, and those living at or below the poverty line in SRO and NYCHA accommodations. Currently, serving 4,000 registered members at our 384 Grand Street, NYC location, our pantry feeds up to 1,000 families per week. Our reservation system ensures that members, as well as walk-in clients, can be served comfortably and safely, without having to wait in long lines during inclement weather.
