PROFESSIONAL ACHIEVEMENT AWARD



Dr. Karen Lin

Karen WeiRu Lin, MD, MS, FAAFP, is the Associate Dean for Global Health, Professor in the Department of Family Medicine and Community Health, and Assistant Director of the Family

Medicine Residency Program at Robert Wood Johnson Medical School.

Dr. Lin is also the faculty advisor for several units within Robert Wood Johnson Medical School that integrate global health: HIPHOP Promise Clinic, a weekly student-run health clinic for underserved populations in New Brunswick; elective courses in medical Mandarin and

complementary and alternative medicine elective courses; Asian Pacific American Medical Student Association; International Health Interest Group; and Physicians for Human Rights.

Among her numerous research projects, she received a seed grant from Rutgers Global Health Institute for the Health Passport to Healthy Living program at HIPHOP Promise Clinic.

Dr. Lin has served on the medical school's executive council and admissions, alternative medicine, and multicultural education committees. She integrates acupuncture into her family medicine practice and facilitated the Chinese American Medicine Initiative and Integrative Healing Program at Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital.

LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD



Yue-Sai Kan

Yue-Sai Kan is an Emmy-winning television host and producer, successful entrepreneur, fashion icon, bestselling author and humanitarian. People magazine called her "the most

famous woman in China" and Time magazine proclaimed her "the Queen of the Middle Kingdom."

In 1972, Yue-Sai created the weekly television series "Looking East", the first of its kind to introduce Asian cultures and customs to American audiences. The series garnered critical acclaim and won dozens of awards. In 1984, PBS invited Yue-Sai to host the first live broadcast of a television program from China on the occasion of the 35th Anniversary of the People's Republic of China. Two years later the television series "One World" produced and hosted by Yue-Sai aired on China's national television

network CCTV, with a weekly viewership of 400 million. It was then the first time a non-Chinese citizen hosted a TV series in China and made her a household name. With her broadcast in both China and the United States, she was then the most watched woman in the world!

In 1992, Yue-Sai created the Yue Sai Cosmetics brand which grew into China's leading Cosmetics Company, selling products in more than 800 outlets through 23 regional companies in China's major markets. More than 90% of the Chinese population today recognizes the brand, which was purchased by L'Oreal in 2004. Additionally, she has written 10 best-selling books, and in 2000, became the first and only living American featured on a Chinese government-issued postage stamp.

Throughout her life, Yue-Sai has been deeply involved in charity work. She served and is still serving on the boards of a number of prominent charitable organizations in China and the United States, including the Shanghai Soong Qing Ling Foundation, Citymeals on Wheels, the Ellis Island Honors Society and Prince Albert of Monaco's Philanthropy Round Table, etc. For years, Yue-Sai was chairing the Miss Universe China Final Pageant which she turned into the most glamorous charity ball in Shanghai. Annually it raised millions to support orphanages, cleft lip and palate correction surgeries and scholarships for students in China's best music, TV and film schools.

Yue-Sai is also the Chairwoman of China Institute, a 96-year-old organization whose mission is to advance a deeper understanding of China through programs in Chinese language, culture, art, culinary art, and business. Her own charitable foundation Yue-Sai Kan China Beauty Charity Fund has been providing scholarships for Chinese students at

the Fashion Institute of Technology and established sustainable fashion educational programs for executives and professionals at Chinese fashion companies. She is a member of the Committee of 100 and was ordained a Dame of Malta in 2022. In 2022, the Schlesinger Library at Harvard University acquired her entire life archival material to further scholarship and the understanding of the history of women in America. In 2023, Yue-Sai Kan China Beauty Charity Fund evolved into Yue-Sai Kan One World Foundation committed to prompt respect, tolerance and cultural inclusivity among individuals, societies and cultures around the world.

ENTREPRENEUR AWARD



Chao Yan

Dr. Chao Yan serves as the Founder and CEO of Princeton NuEnergy. Prior to establishing the company, Dr. Yan held the roles of research scientist and entrepreneur,

specializing in the domains of energy conversion, fuels, and batteries. He is notably recognized as a co-inventor of cutting-edge direct recycling technology for lithium batteries.

Dr. Yan boasts an impressive track record, with numerous high-impact publications and notable conference presentations in the field of physical chemistry and battery materials, solidifying his status as a leading expert in this domain. Dr. Yan earned his Ph.D. in Physical Chemistry from the New Jersey Institute of Technology and completed his post-doctoral research at Princeton University, further cementing his credentials and expertise in this field.

HUMANITARIAN AWARD

Sir Gary Kong

Sir Gary Sze Kong is a renowned self-made real estate mogul, philanthropist, and inspirational figure whose life journey epitomizes the American Dream. Born in Fujian, China,

Sir Gary embarked on an extraordinary journey that led him to become a successful entrepreneur and a dedicated advocate for positive change.

His philanthropic efforts are a testament to his gratitude and commitment to giving back to the community that embraced him. He has provided employment opportunities to hundreds of individuals with backgrounds similar to his own, emphasizing loyalty and hard work as the qualities he values most.

Sir Kong founded the Global Hero Foundation, a nonprofit organization with the noble intention of giving back to society and making a positive impact on the world by addressing pressing global issues. In 2020, Sir Gary Sze Kong was nominated for the World Top 51 Entrepreneurs in Hong Kong and received the Hero of the Day recognition on Fox News for his efforts in assisting the state of New York during the COVID-19 pandemic.

The accolades continued in 2021 with the NBA Award presented by the New York Knicks on Chinese New Year, the Lifetime Achievement Award from President Biden, and the Volunteer Award from President Biden's office, highlighting his enduring dedication to making the world a better place.

Sir Kong's extraordinary journey is marked by a passion for service, entrepreneurship, and cultural diplomacy, making him a true global luminary and a source of inspiration for all.
